High Brass Kennels Health Guarantee

For terms of clarity, High Brass Kennels will be referred to as “Seller” and you are referred to as “Buyer”.

The Buyer has five (5) working days to have the puppy examined by a veterinarian. If the puppy is found to be in unsatisfactory health at that time, the puppy may be returned for a full refund. All transportation costs for the return are the Buyer’s responsibility.

High Brass puppies are guaranteed against Canine Hip Dysplasia for 26 months. Your puppy can OFA at 24 months. This gives owners a 2 month window to complete the x-rays and obtain clearances. Abnormal OFA hips are anything less than FAIR hips. Preliminary reports will not be accepted. We recommend that you take your puppy to the University of Minnesota or a veterinarian that performs many OFA x-rays.

High Brass puppies are guaranteed to be free from genetic eye diseases, RD (Retinal Dysplasia) and PRA (Progressive Retinal Atrophy) for a period of 12 months. You can obtain CERF clearances after 7 weeks of age.

High Brass puppies are guaranteed to be unaffected from Centronuclear Myopathy (**CNM**). By unaffected, the puppy will not come back with a test result of cmn/cmn.

High Brass puppies are guaranteed to be unaffected by Exercise Induced Collapse (**EIC**). By unaffected, the puppy will not come back with a test result of E/E.

Any medical expenses in regards to diagnosis and/or treatment of a genetic hip or eye problem are the sole responsibility of the Buyer for the lifetime of the dog, as are any other veterinary expenses.

All puppies are sold in good faith and no puppy is sold for any specific use or guarantee of performance such as brood bitch, stud dog, show dog, field trial or hunt test competitor. We do guarantee that we have bred only sound dogs with clearances and have researched the pedigrees to the best of our abilities.

When the following requirements are met, this guarantee will be in effect and honored by High Brass Kennels.

- ✓ The dog’s Avid Microchip number must match our records.
- ✓ The dog must be registered with AKC and papers shall revert back to breeder.
- ✓ The dog must not have been bred (NO exceptions).
- ✓ A copy of the reports from OFA and/or CERF and/or EIC and/or CNM results must be sent to us for our records. **Microchip number must be on the report.**

- ✓ Your veterinarian must send a letter to High Brass Kennels stating/confirming the dog has been spayed or neutered and verify the microchip number.

When the seller is satisfied that the requirements were met, the seller will provide a replacement puppy of similar breeding, seller's choice. If the price of the replacement puppy is greater than the original puppy purchased, the buyer will pay the difference. The buyer will assume the expenses of the transportation of the replacement puppy.

If the buyer maintains possession of the affected dog, at no time may the affected dog be sold for money or services.

At no time will the Seller make a refund of money.

This condition of sale and guarantee is not transferable under any circumstances.

Right of First Refusal: If, at any time in the life of your High Brass puppy, it becomes necessary for any reason to give up ownership, High Brass Kennels would appreciate the primary opportunity to obtain ownership of the dog.

The buyer understands these terms and conditions and acknowledges by his/her signature that this is a legally binding document.
